## *Aloha!*

Thank you for your interest in participating in the 2011 *Hawai'i Magnifique Pageants*, to be held on April 9th, 2011 at the Pacific Beach Hotel, Grand Ballroom. This year marks our 9th anniversary and I am very excited to have seen this pageant grow bigger and better each year.

The *Hawai'i Magnifique Pageants* has 3 pageant divisions which you may choose to enter;



- **Miss Hawai'i Magnifique** is a pageant to crown the top butch queen female impersonator in Hawai'i! **You are not allowed to be on hormones or have had any type of body alterations.** This is a prelim pageant to **La Femme Magnifique International** in Portland, Oregon. This pageant combines the skinny and plus pageants from years past into one, the winner has the option to run for the International Plus pageant if they make the requirements. You must be a resident of Hawai'i.
- **Mr. Hawai'i Magnifique** is a pageant to crown to most talented male entertainer in Hawai'i. You don't have to be born male to run, but you must identify as being a male. Being on testosterone or having had body alterations does not apply to this pageant division.
- **Miss Hawai'i Magnifique Goddess** is a pageant to crown the most entertaining goddess illusionist in all of Hawai'i. This is a new pageant division this year and is an open division to ALL whether on hormones or not.

Enclosed you will find the guidelines for this year's pageant, the contestant application form, a contestant bio sheet for the program book, and important information to help you plan accordingly. When turning in these forms please include a **non returnable professional quality** headshot for the program and other advertisements.

There is a \$200.00 non refundable entrance fee; \$50.00 will be reimbursed upon completion of the pageant and proper clean up of contestant area. Reimbursements will be distributed only at the post pageant party, to be held the next day along with a rundown of scores and judges comments.

You are given one (1) dresser wrist band. Extra dresser wrist bands may be purchased for \$50.00 each; maximum of two (2). These people are the only one allowed to assist you in whatever you may need; make-up, hair, costumes, etc. You will not be able to switch dresser wrist bands with another person.



There are four (4) categories in which you will be judged. Your categories will be scoring from 1-20, with 20 being the highest. We will have seven (7) judges of various judging backgrounds. The highest and lowest score will be dropped and the five (5) scores left will be calculated as your final score. There is a possible total of 100 points per category and an overall possible score of 400 points for the pageant. If there is a tie the high and low scores will be factored back in to break it.

**1. Evening Gown (Females)** - For this category you will wear a **FLOOR LENGTH GOWN** of any color, style, or material. Judges criteria include: Gown Presentation, Make up, Hair Style, Poise, and Stage Presence. House Music will be provided.

**Swimwear (Males)** - For this category you will wear a swim suit of any color, style, or material. Judges criteria include: Swimsuit, Poise, and Stage Presence. House Music will be provided.

**2. Theme Competition:** This year's theme is "**UNDER THE DEEP BLUE SEA**". Creativity is crucial so explore your wildest fantasies, the sky is the limit. Have FUN with the theme. Judges criteria include: Creativity, Originality, Construction, Poise, and Stage Presence. House Music will be provided.

A description of your theme costume will need to be provided. Your description will be read out loud prior to you coming on stage to present your costume. ***This description should be no longer than four (4) sentences long and needs to be turned in 2 weeks prior to the pageant.***



**3. Talent Competition:** Your talent presentation is **limited to five (5) minutes**. You may include other performers in your presentation. Judges criteria include: Talent, Entertainment, Poise, and Presentation. Talent division is limited to five (5) minutes. Use of Fire, Water, Confetti, and Weapons is strictly prohibited. All large or over sized props need to be cleared by producers first. Please be considerate of all contestants when performing your talent, all left over residue and debris should be cleaned up at the completion of your talent. Points will be deducted to your overall score if you fail to abide by any of these conditions.



**4. Showgirl/Showboy Competition:** This one is the "**BIGGIE**". The glamorous and glorious evening climaxes with the Las Vegas style Showgirl/Showboy Costume look. It is to your advantage to construct your costumes well. Keeping in mind that **BIGGER IS NOT NECESASARILY BETTER**. While parading around in your costume you must be able to walk freely and as if nothing is restricting your movement. Judges Criteria include: Creativity, Originality, Construction, Poise, and Presentation.

Please provide your own music TALENT and SHOWGIRL/SHOWBOY. ***CDs must be turned in two (2) weeks prior to the pageant.*** In the event of duplications the contestant's CD with the earliest postmark will be allowed to perform/use the song. The other contestant must choose another selection.

You are also allowed to use back up dancers for your theme division and talent division. No limit on the number of dancers. Although a \$20.00 dancer wrist band will need to be bought for any dancer or stage hand you need for your categories. This wrist band will be their admission to the pageant and to the backstage, however if they intend to sit down and enjoy the pageant they will need to purchase a seat ticket. Your dresser and dancers wrist bands will be distributed during the pageant rehearsal; if they do not have or wear the wrist bands at the time of the pageant they will not be allowed admission to the pageant or backstage area. No Exceptions!

Contestants will be required to be on time for rehearsal at 10:00am and for contestant check in at 5:00pm. A five (5) point deduction from your overall score will be applied for each tardiness, a possible total deduction of minus ten (10) points. Again, remember every point counts!

On the day of the pageant you will be provided a contestant table, and two (2) chairs. Lights and clothes racks are your responsibility. You are allowed to start bringing in any costumes at 12 noon; however we will not be responsible for any loss, theft, or damage to them at any point. You are responsible for keeping your area clean and must check with the backstage manager prior to leaving once the pageant is over, failure to do so will result in a loss of your \$50.00 clean up fee. We encourage you to lay down a sheet in your area to catch the excess droppings of pageant primping.

Once the date has been set for ticket releases we will notify you. Your contestant application, bio, photo, and entrance fee needs to be turned in before being issued tickets. For outer island contestants we will work closely with you to ensure you get all necessary information. It is very important that we have your most current contact information and for you to keep me posted of any changes. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.

5:00pm - Final Contestant Check In\*

7:00pm – General Admission Ticket Holders Are Allowed Entrance

7:30pm – Buffet Lines Close and Pageant Starts

***\*Indicates that tardiness will result in a five (5) point deduction of overall score.***
